You are invited to be a witness to Catholic engagement in society and to learn more about the major political parties' platforms by attending the Archdiocese of Toronto's first-ever federal election debate.

Representatives from the major political parties will discuss how they plan to address issues of importance to Canada's Catholic community—some topics include poverty, life issues, Christian persecution and climate change.

Cardinal Thomas Collins will lead us in prayer and reflect on the election at the beginning and the end of the evening. Don Newman, an award-winning journalist with decades of experience facilitating political discussions, will moderate the debate.

While the tickets for the debate at the Metro Convention Centre are already taken, four viewing locations have been added at Holy Spirit Parish in Barrie, St. Edward the Confessor Parish, in Nrth York, St. Josepht the Worker Parish in Oshawa and St. Mary's Parish in Brampton.
