Feast of All Souls In Memoriam Mass for Deceased Loved Ones

On Saturday, November 2, the Feast of All Souls, in addition to our regularly scheduled Masses, we will have a Mass at 7:00 pm to pray for all those who have died. If you know someone who has lost a loved one this past year, invite them to join us on this special feast to remember the loved ones who have passed away.

And always, we will continue our custom here at Our Lady of Lourdes, of offering *In Memoriam* cards with the names of deceased family and friends to be prayed for during the month of November. During all the Masses on Saturday, November 2, the Feast of All Souls, at each of our Masses, you will have an opportunity to bring the cards up and place them in the urn at the front of the Church. Blank In Memoriam cards will be inserted into the bulletin the weekend of October 27.

The Archdiocese of Toronto wants every eligible Catholic to vote in the Federal election on October 21, 2019. As a charity, the Archdiocese must remain nonpartisan and cannot direct the Catholic community to vote for a particular candidate or party. What we can do is educate voters to ensure they are informed to make a responsible decision on Election Day. We can also share information on issues from a Catholic perspective. Visit the Archdiocese's federal election site at www.archtoronto.org/election where you will find backgrounders, infographics and videos. The topics include: the Environment, Human Dignity, Indigenous Issues, Newcomers, Political Participation, Poverty and Religious Freedom. These resources are intended to help you discern your vote. The archdiocese hopes that every eligible Catholic will be informed on the issues and will cast a ballot on election day, October 21, 2019.
