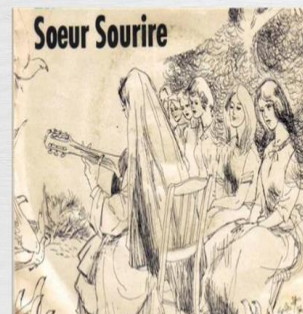
### Volunteers Needed for our Annual Parish Bazaar

## LOURDES PARISH FOLLOW-UP TO 2023 SYNOD REPORT: 26 MAY 24

As a lead-up to Pope Francis’ 2023 papal synod in Rome last fall, we here at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish committed ourselves to a series of 10 “listening sessions” in which 10 different groups of parishioners came together to discuss the important issues that impact the faith experience of our parish and its very diverse community.

Following this attempt to build a disciple-based “synodal way” that might contribute to parish renewal, a number of changes have been and are still being implemented at Lourdes. Pope Francis has asked that each Catholic diocese throughout the world be given follow-up reports by individual parishes for submission to Rome in anticipation of a concluding Synod of bishops that will be held in the fall of 2024.

Fr. Mbugua is asking for representatives of our many parish ministries to come together on Saturday, 26 May, from 1 to 4 PM to discuss the ways in which the parish Synod report we submitted early last year has been implemented at the parish level. We are asking for the main facilitators of each parish ministry to attend, accompanied by 2 or 3 additional active members of your ministry. A report based on this follow-up session will be submitted to the Archdiocese by 1 June.
