

### IN SOLIDARITY WITH THE SYNOD

Very actively involved in the preparatory stage prior to the first session of the Synod on Synodality, 2023, Our Lady of Lourdes continues to pray for and with the participants of the second session underway this month. One point that is being addressed in a Forum comes from the third paragraph of the Instrumentum Laboris 2024. The paragraph states, "The People of God is never simply the sum of the baptised; rather, it is the 'we' of the Church, the communitarian and historical subject of synodality and mission". The speakers and participants in the Forum will engage with this statement from various perspectives. The underlying question is: What does it mean that the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ in word and deed— "the mission"—is entrusted to "a people"?

As a community of Our Lady of Lourdes, you are invited to bring the same question to prayer. Stay tuned for some of the reflections on this topic from the groups in Rome once the reports are available.
