
Household Saints (1993) [Women Filmmakers]

The final film in the illustrious career of beloved star Maggie Smith, this gentle comedy/ drama about a small-town trio of singers who win a pilgrimage to Lourdes will appeal to adults both younger and older. While a trip to Lourdes has been the lifelong dream of Lily (Maggie Smith), her BFF Eileen (Kathy Bates) wishes to go there to pray for the healing of a tumour, and their fellow singer Dolly hopes that a visit to Lourdes will cure her son's inability to speak. In Lourdes, the women may not receive the healings they seek, but nevertheless find healings they never expected. (A number of mature themes make this a film for adults only.)

St. Paul's Basilica, Toronto (Bishop Kasun to preside)


Thursday, February 20, 2025, 7PM:
