In preparation for our upcoming Parish Picnic, we need volunteers to help with the preparation of the event. If you are interested, please call the Parish Office at 416-924-6257.

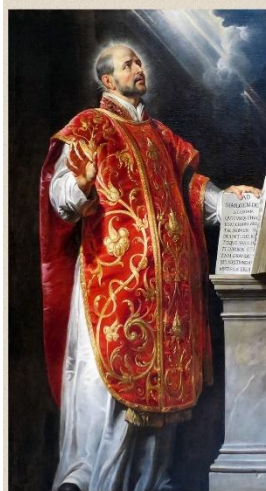


