Pope Leo XIV 18 January 2026

Speaking after the Angelus on 18 January, Pope Leo XIV recalled the origins of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, which begins today and dates back two centuries. Recalling the origins of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity last Sunday, "the initiative [] was "strongly encouraged" by Pope Leo XIII and, exactly one hundred years ago, was enriched for the first time by the *Suggestions for the Octave of Prayer for the Unity of Christians*.

The Pope recalled that the theme of this year's Week [was] taken from Saint Paul's Letter to the Ephesians: "*There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling*" (Eph 4:4). The prayers and reflections, he said, were prepared by an ecumenical group coordinated by the Department for Interreligious Relations of the Armenian Apostolic Church.

"I therefore invite all Catholic communities," Pope Leo XIV said, "to intensify their prayer during these days for the full, visible unity of all Christians."

May we continue to be conscious of and engage in ongoing prayer for the unity of all Christians.
